

# **The 20th International SHR Symposium**

## **The Ogihara Award**

One investigator for the Ogihara Award is selected by the programme committee from the abstracts submitted to the Symposium and considered to be the most suitable for the Award. The Accessory Prize is 100,000 Japanese yen and the awardee's age should be below 40 at the end of March 2023. The Ogihara Award is selected from abstracts submitted to both the 58th Japanese SHR Meeting and the 20th International SHR Symposium. The Ogihara Award is given to the first author of an abstract that receives the highest score in the abstract's peer review results.

## **The Nagai Award**

One investigator for the Nagai Award is selected by the directors of the Society and Professor Nagai from the abstracts submitted by those who have made remarkable achievements in the field of systems biology, and considered to be the most suitable for the Award. The Accessory Prize is 100,000 Japanese yen and the awardee's age should be below 45 at the end of March 2023. The Nagai Award is selected from abstracts submitted to the 58th Japanese SHR Meeting; the applicants will be requested to additionally submit the specific application documents (in Japanese), which are sent from the congress secretariat after initial abstract submission.

## **The SHR Society Award 2022**

According to the tradition of International SHR Symposium, the first authors of a few (the number is changeable depending on the situation) excellent oral or poster presentations are selected by the directors of the Society from abstracts submitted to both the 58th Japanese SHR Meeting and the 20th International SHR Symposium and the certain amount of Accessory Prize (70,000 Japanese yen in two former Symposia) is given to the awardees whose age should be below 40 at the end of March 2023.
